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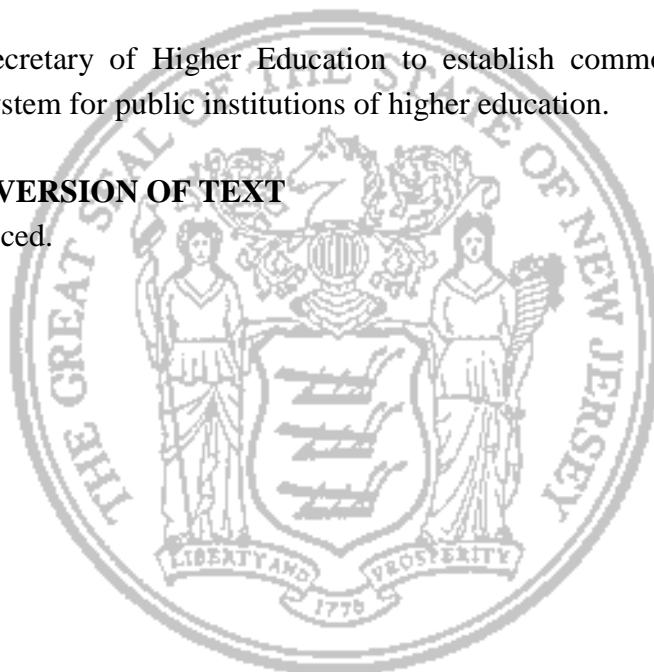

**SYNOPSIS**

Directs Secretary of Higher Education to establish common core course numbering system for public institutions of higher education.

1 AN ACT concerning the establishment of a common core course  
2 numbering system at public institutions of higher education and  
3 supplementing chapter 62 of Title 18A of the New Jersey  
4 Statutes.

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6 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*  
7 *of New Jersey:*

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9 1. a. The Secretary of Higher Education and the New Jersey  
10 President's Council, in consultation with each public institution of  
11 higher education, shall develop, implement, and maintain a common  
12 core course numbering system for general education core classes  
13 leading to an associate degree or a baccalaureate degree at a public  
14 institution.

15 b. The common core course numbering system shall be fully  
16 operational by September 1, 2016.

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18 2. An independent institution of higher education in the State  
19 may elect to participate in the common core course numbering  
20 system.

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22 3. This act shall take effect immediately.

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STATEMENT

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27 Under this bill, the Secretary of Higher Education and the New  
28 Jersey President's Council, in consultation with each public  
29 institution of higher education, will develop, implement, and  
30 maintain a common core course numbering system for general  
31 education core classes leading to an associate degree or a  
32 baccalaureate degree. The common core course numbering system  
33 must be fully operational by September 1, 2016. An independent  
34 institution of higher education in the State may choose to participate  
35 in the common core course numbering system.
